

Memorandum of Society

of RAO BHARAT SINGH EDUCATION SOCIETY

- 1 Name of the Society RAO BHARAT SINGH EDUCATION SOCIETY
- 2 The Registered Office of VILL- MEOKA, SECTOR 91, PO WAZIPUR GURGAON-123505
the Society shall be at:
- 3 Jurisdiction The Society shall work within Gurgaon District
territory of State of Haryana.
- 4 (i) Aims and Objects of the Society
- To open and develop education institution from pre-primary stage till higher education such as early intervention of their interest & develop their interest areas and identify the abilities & education needs including vocational and technical education.
 - To encourage, assist and develop taste for Computer education, Indian Music, Dance, Drama, Painting and fine arts and crafts by manage vocational organizing concerts, competitions, demonstrations and symposium.
 - To conduct and manage classes, institution and other similar activities for providing basic education, training, imparting knowledge and teaching skills in all spheres of human activities such as domestic science, literacy, languages, etc.
 - To start, maintain or otherwise manage libraries, reading rooms, vocational centers, hostels or other centers of similar nature.
- V. To aid or establish, take over independent or in collaboration with any c. institution for provide food, clothes, medical aid, stationery, transportation, laboratories, reading rooms, hostels, play ground and other possible facilities to needy public for development & benefit of rural & urban areas.
- VI. To organize conferences, seminars, study groups, workshops, publish literature to conduct research with special reference in the field incidental or consequential to attain the object of the society.
- VII. To collect, raise and enhance the funds of the society through receipt of donations, grant from central or state government, subscriptions, holding programs and functions.
- VIII. To acquire land & premises from Central Govt. of India, Haryana state acquisition, for establishing, operating and promoting for the above stated objects.
- IX. To do all such acts, things and deeds which may be deemed necessary to carry out and fulfill aims and objects of the society.
- 4 (ii) Other Objects:-
- (A.) Either the income or property of the society will be spent only for the benefit of the society and no part of the income will be given to any other person/society in the form of Bonus & Dividend.
- (B.) All the members of the Society will be honorary and shall not be paid any amount responsible for the property, assets and the liabilities of the Society. In that case the Society Committee, it will be paid through the Society funds. The Interest on the amount taken by any member(s) of the Society and the rent of the building for the Society shall be paid by the Society funds.
- (C.) Income/Profit shall be spent for the benefit of the Society.
- (D.) In the event of the closure of the Society by any reason No member will be individually responsible for the property, assets and the liabilities of the Society. In that case the Society Rules & Regulations.
- (E.) HONORARY MEMBERS: Any eminent scholar, scientist, writer, worker or specialist in any line would be enrolled as honorary member for such period as it would consider fit. Member can be removed by 2/3rd majority subject to approval of the Society committee. In case he/she found indiscipline in the society bankrupt, guilty of working against the interest of society. The removal/refusal shall be communicated to concerned member in writing. The member does not pay the membership fee within three months his/her name will be canceled at the sole discretion of the managing committee of the Governing Body.
- (F.) IDENTITY CARDS: Every person admitted as a member shall be issued identification card by the Society containing the photograph and particulars of such persons.
- 5 Re-admission of expelled/suspended members
- Any member expelled/suspended can be readmitted by 3/4th members of the annual general meeting, however no such member who has been convicted of an offence amounting to moral turpitude or who has been removed from the membership on the directions of the District Registrar/Registrar/Registrar General shall be re-admitted.
- 6 Member's Rights/Privileges and duties
- The members of the Society will have to appoint new Governing Body at the Annual General Meeting and also they can appoint such body in Extraordinary Annual General Meeting if required. All members will assist in arranging funds/ donations when required.
- 7 Definition of General Body
- "General Body" means and refers to the body of members of a society are elected by members of Society at annual general meeting. All the members of the Society as mentioned in categories (above) shall form General Body in Annual General Meeting.
- 8 Size of the Governing Body
- The size of Governing Body including office bearers are as under:-

- 9 Term of Governing Body
- The Governing Body appointed in annual meeting of members will have one year or till next annual general meeting.
- 10 Requirement of Notice of meeting of the Governing Body
- Secretary shall circulate among Governing Body members notice enclosing agenda specifying date, time and place.
- 11 Quorum of Meetings
- 50 % of the members shall form the quorum of every meeting of the Governing Body. However there is no quorum within half-hour time, the members present meeting will proceed with the agenda of the meeting.
- 12 Governing Body and urgent Meetings
- Correct record of the proceedings of every meeting of the Governing Body kept by the Secretary.
- 13 Powers of Governing Body
- The Secretary shall call the annual general meeting of the Society during the next first quarter of the financial year ended to conduct the business. To adopt annual report of the Society.
- 14 Office-bearer of Society and their Powers
- PRESIDENT: To preside over all the meetings in the absence of the President and exercise all the powers of the President after obtaining specific sanction same by a resolution of the Governing Body.
- VICE PRESIDENT: To preside over the meetings in the absence of the President and exercise all the powers of the President after obtaining specific sanction same by a resolution of the Governing Body.
- SECRETARY: To keep and prepare all records of the Society and minute General Body to conduct all such correspondence relating to the Society, call, exercise power to appointments, removal, discharge, engagements, suspensions, and increment of staff and consultants with the consultation of the Governing Body members. The secretary is fully empowered to any query personally or in court as and when required. He can delegate powers to any other life member with the approval of the members of the Governing Body.
- 15 General Secretary / Secretary
- 16 Management of funds by Treasurer
- 17 Provision for filling-up casual vacancies
- 18 Sources of Income of a Society
- The Society shall seek fees, subscription, donation and also can raise loans as per requirement. Annual subscription & donations shall be treated as per income of the Society, unless donation is for some specific purpose such as building, assets, etc.
- The Governing Body will arrange finance if required from other banks, institutions individual or reasonable terms and conditions and the Society as a whole is liable for its return. The Society may also raise funds by donations and grants from departments and other organizations.
- 19 Provisions relating to Audit of the Society's Accounts
- The financial year shall be counted from 1st April to 31st March. The Accounts shall be audited by Chartered Accountant appointed on the recommendation of the Governing Body.
- 20 Operations of Bank Accounts
- The Bank Accounts will be opened in any Bank and shall be opened and operated by two Governing Body members as decided in Governing Body meeting.
